Class A (Family Golf Membership) entitles you, your dependant family and any grandchildren (age 18 & under) to all Club facilities which consist of golf, swimming, tennis and dining.

Class A-1 (Single Golf Membership) entitles an unmarried individual who may invite an unmarried non-member paying appropriate guest fees while in the company of such member, to all Club facilities which consist of golf, swimming, tennis, and dining.

Class B (Family Social Membership) entitles you, your dependant family and any grandchildren (age 18 & under) to the following Club facilities: swimming, tennis and dining. You may also have golf privileges, which means that you will have to pay greens fees.

Class B-1 (Single Social Membership) entitles an unmarried individual who may invite an unmarried non-member while in the company of such member, to the same facilities as a Class B membership.

Class D (Out-of-Town Family Membership) consists of you, your dependant family and any grandchildren (age 18 & under) who reside outside of a 30-mile radius of downtown Waynesboro to use of all Club facilities which consist of golf, swimming, tennis and dining. If you own or lease a dwelling suitable for living within the 30-mile radius, you are not eligible for this class of membership.

Class D-1 (Out-of-Town Single Membership) entitles an unmarried individual who may invite an unmarried non-member while in the company of such member who reside outside of a 30-mile radius of downtown Waynesboro to use of all Club facilities which consist of golf, swimming, tennis and dining. If you own or lease a dwelling suitable for living within the 30-mile radius, you are not eligible for this class of membership.

Class E (Dining Membership) This classification shall provide a membership for full use of the restaurant and limited social functions for an individual, husband and wife, or family, and all unmarried children eighteen (18) and under; or children who are over the age of eighteen (18) but less than twenty-six (26). Members seeking this classification will not be sold stock.

Class R (Family Retired Membership) entitles you, your spouse and any grandchildren (age 18 and under) to all Club facilities except that you may not begin play on the golf course on Saturday, Sunday or holidays until after 2:00 p.m. from March 1 – October 31. During November 1 – February 28, you do not have any restrictions. To qualify for this membership class, you must be age sixty-two (62) and over.

Class R (Family Retired Membership) entitles an unmarried individual, who must be age sixty-two (62) and over who may invite an unmarried non-member paying appropriate guest fees while in the company of such member, to all Club facilities with the same restrictions and qualifications as a Class R membership.

Class J (Family Junior Membership) entitles you and your dependant family to all Club facilities. To qualify for this membership class, the oldest partner's age for the married couple must be at least eighteen (18) years of age. This membership class does not include anyone over the age of thirty-nine (39). At the age of forty (40), he or she must become a member of the appropriate class and must purchase stock to remain in the Club.

Class J-1 (Single Junior Membership) entitles an unmarried individual, who must be at least eighteen (18) years of age but not over the age of thirty-nine (39) and who may invite an unmarried non-member while in the company of such member to all Club facilities. At the age of forty (40), he or she must become a member of the appropriate class and must purchase stock to remain in the Club.

Class T (Tennis Membership) entitles you, your dependant family and any grandchildren (age 18 & under) to tennis and dining privileges only.

Golf Legacy Class

A member in any class in good standing may sponsor a membership of an immediate family member (s) for a Legacy membership. These memberships have the entrance fees waived, otherwise they have all the privileges and obligations associated with A, A-1, J and J-1 membership.

Golf Transfer Class

Applicants for this membership must currently be members in good standing at a private club with initiation equal or greater than currently being charged at Waynesboro Country Club. They must give up their current membership and sign a one (1) year membership contract with Waynesboro Country Club. This membership has the entrance fee waived and stock purchase is required per the appropriate membership. This class includes Class A, A-1, B, B-1, R, R-1 J and J-1 membership.

Membership Agreement

Membership Deposit Amount

A check in the amount of \$250.00 is required as a deposit with the application. If membership is approved the said deposit fee will be applied first to the purchase of WCC stock and then to dues and assessments. All application must be approved by the Membership Committee before membership becomes effective. Applications will be processed promptly. WCC stock must be purchased within 30 days of application approval.

This Application & Agreement must be completed in its entirety and accompanied with a check before returning it to the Club's Business Office.

Food & Beverage Minimum

The Food and Beverage Minimum is \$40.00 per month for (A, J, & R) family memberships and \$30.00 per moth for (A-1, J-1, & R-1) single memberships. If you do not spend at least the minimal food minimum from the 1st of the month until the end of the month, you will be billed the difference. The food minimum includes food and beverage charges only. It does not include tax or gratuity.

2006 Capital Assessment Fee

There currently is a capital assessment fee of \$11.00 per month for Classes A, A-1, J, J-1, R & R-1. This 2006 capital assessment fee will be billed through May 2011.

Statements and Payments

Statement balances must be paid monthly on or before the 20th of the following month. Accounts not paid by month end will be charged a 10% late penalty on the balance due. You may make your payment using either cash or check. We currently do not accept credit card payments at this time.

Agreement

We are (I am) joining under a zero (0) Entrance Fee, therefore we (I) agree to remain a member in good standing for a minimum of one (1) year, requiring payment of one (1) year dues, assessments & food minimum to WCC before this Agreement can be terminated. Changes in type of Membership or Leave of Absence will not be available to the memberships until WCC has received one year of dues, including food minimum and assessments. Of this application is accepted, it is understood that the membership shall be a continuing membership, automatically renewable from year to year unless terminated by either party with one (1) calendar month's notice in writing. Upon termination of membership (regardless of reason), it is expressly understood and agreed that any stock acquired by virtue of membership shall be sold back to Waynesboro Country Club, Inc. at par value. All dues and charges are due and payable through your termination date. Charges include, but are not limited to, the monthly food minimum, all assessments and any purchases you have.
